






PETITION AGAINST ORDINANCE NUMBER 2017-10

We, the undersigned, are registered voters and residents of the Township of Verona, County of Essex, State of New Jersey, and constitute not less than 15 (fifteen) percent of the total votes cast in the Township of Verona at the last election at which members of the General Assembly were elected. We hereby protest the adoption of Ordinance Number 2017-10 (2017), adopted by the Verona Town Council on May 1, 2017. We hereby request that Ordinance Number 2017-10 (2017), which authorizes the purchase of the real property located at 56 Grove Avenue, in the Township of Verona, New Jersey, Block 1605, Lot 20, be reconsidered and repealed by the Verona Town Council or that it be submitted to a vote of the residents of the Township of Verona at the next regular election. 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TOWNSHIP OF VERONA, BLOCK 1605, LOT 20 (the "Property")

WHEREAS, the Township of Verona is desirous of purchasing the real property located at 56 Grove Avenue, in the Township of Verona, New Jersey, Block 1605, Lot 20, for a purchase price of \$900,000 to use for municipal purposes; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:12-5(a) provides that any municipality, by ordinance, may provide for the acquisition of any real property (1) by purchase; and

WHEREAS, subject to a bond ordinance being approved by the Council, funds will be available to make said purchase.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Township of Verona, County of Essex, New Jersey, as follows:

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SECTION 2. If any section, sub-section, paragraph, sentence or any other part of this ordinance is adjudged unconstitutional or invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder of this ordinance.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances which are inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days after final passage and publication as prescribed by law.
